- Flexor Digitorum Longus for Hammertoe Deformity
- Jones Tenosuspension for Hallux Malleus Deformity

▪ **Midfoot and Rearfoot Tendon Transfers**

- Split Tibialis Anterior Tendon Transfer for Correction of Spastic Varus Deformity
- Posterior Tibial Tendon Transfer through the Interosseous Membrane for Dropfoot Deformity
- Flexor Digitorum Longus Transfer for Adult Acquired Flatfoot Deformity
- Flexor Hallucis Longus Transfer for Achilles Tendinopathy
