

## SHOW ME THE MONEY – How to Find Your Hospital’s GME Funding

Each year COTH purchases the latest GME funding information available from CMS and places that information on the COTHweb site for AACPM teaching hospital members to access at their convenience.

Here are instructions to locating the information and calculating the “Per Resident Amount (PRA).”

1. In your Internet browser, visit and bookmark [www.cothweb.org](http://www.cothweb.org).
2. Navigate to the “Members” section and enter your UserID and password when prompted.
3. When you are in the “Members” side of the website, select the “GME” page.
4. Enter your institution’s “Medicare ID” or “Facility Name” and click “Search.”
5. The information returned will look like this example:

<b>IME Per Resident:</b>	\$113,418.55
<b>Part A DGME Payments:</b>	\$1,556,622.00
<b>Part B DGME Payments:</b>	\$427,587.00
<b>Total IME Payments:</b>	\$4,622,940.00
➔ <b>Total DGME and IME Payments:</b>	\$6,607,149.00
<b>Total DSH Payments:</b>	\$1,841,809.00
<b>Uncompensated Care Payments:**</b>	\$3,453,300.00
<b>Total Operating Expenses:</b>	\$378,043,692.00

6. To calculate the total amount of money received PER resident (Per Resident Amount or PRA), divide “Total DGME and IME Payments” for the facility by “Total FTE Residents” at the facility.

Example using the above data:

**Total DGME and IME Payments:** \$6,607,149.00  
**Total FTE Residents:** 40.76

**\$6,607,149 / 40.76 = \$162,098.84 PER RESIDENT AMOUNT**
